On 14<sup>th</sup>August again, an awareness rally was organized which was aimed at spreading the message on environment protection. The slogans used for the rally was effective in the sense it got a mass attention in the local villages, nearby markets.

Approximately, 200 participants including 150 NSS volunteers have participated in the program.







#### Activity 13: Relief works for Amphan Cyclone (23-05-2020 to 28-05-2020)

Super Cyclonic Storm Amphan had caused widespread damage in Khejuri Block II along with the other parts of Eastern India during 16 May -21 May 2020. The widespread of COVID along with the damages caused by Amphan had worsened the situation where normal life was greatly divested. To provide the relief aids to sustain daily life of the most vulnerable children and families the NSS volunteers have extended their hands. The volunteers of three units with the help of Khejuri College administration & staff and Sarvodaya Sangha, drinking water, food grains, vegetables, etc were distributed to the villagers of Baratala and Maldah village in the vicinity of college campus.
